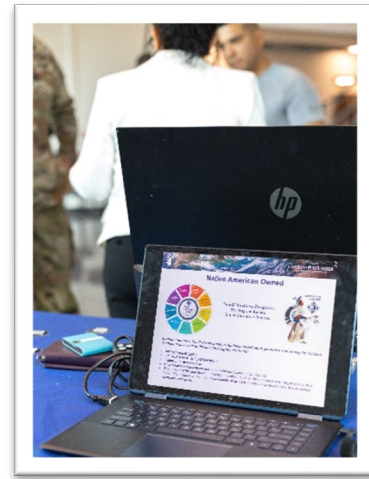


June 2024 - 117th Space Battalion Army Recruiting Event

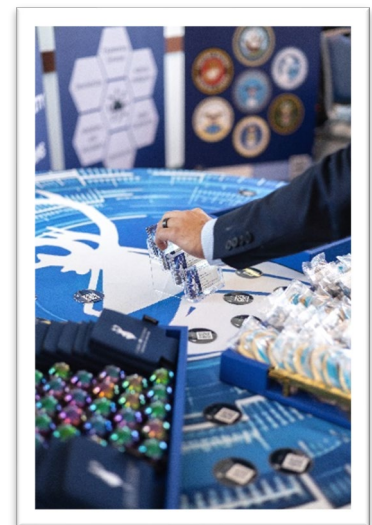
